

## Let's Remember : Kenneth Hagin

#### THE RHEMA WORD HAS POWER BY DEBORAH ASKEW



According to Reverend Hagin's testimony he was born with a deformed heart and an incurable blood disease. He was not expected to live and at 15 became paralyzed and bedridden. On August 8, 1934, he states he was miraculously raised from his deathbed by the power of God and the revelation of "faith in God's Word" after praying Mark 11:23-24.

Reverend Kenneth E. Hagin was the founder of Kenneth Hagin ministries and an internationally known preacher, teacher and author. His teachings and books are filled with vivid stories that show God's power and truth working in his life and the lives of others. These teachings also include vital subjects of faith, prayer, the Holy Spirit and His gifts, and healing. In 1967, he began a regular radio broadcast that continues today as "Rhema for Today." In 1974 he founded Rhema Bible Training Center. In 1979, he founded the Prayer and Healing Center to provide a place for the sick to build their faith through praying God's Word. Reverend Hagin often spoke of the ways he would pray. He discussed how, not by the leading of the Holy Spirit, he would get up between 2AM and 4 AM Monday through Friday and pray. But he also discussed many times in his books his experiences praying with the leading of the Holy Spirit. In his books he discusses how he would be in meetings and a great burden would come over him to pray. One such occasion was when he was in a church service and prior to entering the stage he was extremely burdened with the need to pray. He took the stage and with the congregation began praying in the Spirit. He didn't know why or whom he was praying for; but after several hours he felt victory over the situation. Later, he found out they were praying for a church member who had been caught in a fire explosion with 17 other men. The firemen didn't think anyone would be alive after 24 hours of trying to reach them but all 18 men were alive. Reverend Hagin knew it was through their prayers that these men were saved from the fire.

Mark 11:23-24 ."For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore, I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."
