ORAL ROBERTS BY MIT DEBORAH ASKEW

GOD'S GREAT EVANGELIST (1/24/1918 – 12/15/2009)

Three months prior to Oral's birth his mother was called to pray for a neighbor's child who was seriously ill. As she was crossing the field, she stooped to climb through a fence. Sensing the presence of God in the stirring of the wind, she made a vow to God. She vowed that if God would heal the child and give her a baby boy she would dedicate her son to God for the ministry. God healed the neighbor's child that night and she like Hannah kept her vow. When Oral Roberts was born, his mother dedicated him to God and prayed that God would call him into the ministry.

At 17, Oral Roberts collapsed and was diagnosed in the final stages of tuberculosis. He was bedridden for 163 days with no chance of survival, wasting away. His brother took him to a revival where a man was praying for the sick. On the way to the service, Roberts heard God tell him that He was going to heal Oral and that He wanted Oral to take His healing power to his generation. At the service the man prayed for Oral and God healed him. Oral was a stutterer and God loosed his tongue that night also.

In 1948 Oral Roberts began the first of many tent crusades in which God performed many miracles. Over the 20 years of tent crusades, thousands of people were saved, blessed, and healed. In 1955, the first tent crusade was televised and from 1955 to May, 1967 the ministry was on television. In 1965, Oral Roberts opened the Oral Roberts University in Tulsa Oklahoma. Oral Roberts major contribution to the Christian church was the joining together of prayer and medicine. He was instrumental in making prayers a vital force in various areas of our society; the business and professional world, the educational world, the church world, the entertainment world, as well as the medical

5. Shows us things to come in prayer (John 16:13).

6. Prays for us according to the perfect will of God (Romans 8:26-27).
