Let's Remember

Marilyn Hickey
July 1, 1931 - Present

Ms. Marilyn Hickey is an American Christian Minister, who teaches Bible studies both nationally and internationally. She says that “living a simple life of prayer and praise may be the most powerful thing we can do to reach the world with the good news.”

For nearly 50 years Ms. Hickey and her daughter Sarah Bowling have empowered people to tap into the life-changing power of the gospel through prayer and Bible teaching, Marilyn and Sarah Ministries is a global ministry responding to God’s call to cover the earth with the Word and connect every one with the heart of God.

Marilyn relates an incident early in her life when she was ready to quit ministering. Her daughter Sarah was 5 years old and needed to be picked up from school but Marilyn had to host a church event. The woman who was to pick up her daughter went to the wrong street. Her daughter prayed and walked home safely. (Even at a young age Marilyn taught her daughter to pray.) Feeling guilty, Marilyn prayed and told the Lord that it was hard to do church work while her daughter needed her. Marilyn said God told her, “When you’re about My business, I’m about your business.”
