Dr. Tony Evans' book excerpts on prayer:

·“Prayer is God’s mechanism for grabbing the invisible and making it visible in our lives. But in our prayers we are not making God do something. Rather, prayer allows God to release His decreed will in our lives. By studying and understanding God’s Word; we are encouraged to continue praying until something happens.”

·“Kingdom prayer is the divinely authorized methodology to access heavenly authority for earthly intervention. The goal of Kingdom prayer is to touch heaven in order to change earth.”
